1. Question: The mechanical do not show any outside air for split system units. Is outside air going to be required?

1. Answer: Bid as per plans and specs. The HVAC is good as is; there will be no ducted outside air.

2. Question: In Section 01525 of the specifications it calls for a SSHO which we will provide. However it also calls for a Certified Safety Professional (CSP) and /or Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH) in paragraph 1.7.1.2. in Paragraph 1.7.1.3 it calls for a Associate Safety professional (ASP), Certified Safety Trained Supervisor (STS) and/or Construction Health and Safety Technician (CHST).

My question is are the CIH or ASP personnel requirements necessary? These personnel are rather expensive and will cost the government a lot of money. I would think that the SSHO as designated on the previous page of the specs would be sufficient. Also if they are necessary will they have to be onsite at all times?

2. Answer: The same individual may perform the SSHO, CSP, CIH, ASP, STS, CHST duties if that person is appropriately qualified. Furthermore, the same individual may perform the Superintendent, SSHO, and QC duties if that person is appropriately qualified for all three functions.
